- Continue building the leadership cadre for secondary science.
- Increase available services for Special Education – speech, language and hearing.
- Develop field guide for health related services for school districts.

## ***Connect parents and other adults to enhance a child's readiness for school learning.***

### **What:**

- Provide school readiness leadership for early childhood providers and for teachers of kindergarten through grade 2.
