Technology Planning

ETSC can meet with district administrators and School Improvement Planning staff to help facilitate and inform you on developing technology plans for building and district initiatives.

Peer Coaching

The Peer Coaching program trains school instructional leaders on becoming building technology coaches who can in turn train their own colleagues on how to effectively use technology resources as classroom learning tools. Participants engage in 10 days of training in coaching skills, technology integration, and lesson design. They also attend other ETSC classes at no cost.
